# PARCEL NO. 8-EL

The following parcel located in the City of Columbus, Franklin County, and State of Ohio, and being part of a tract of land containing 300 acres acquired by the State of Ohio from William S. Sullivant, May 24, 1870, and recorded in Volume 101, Page 390 in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, and lying on the left side of a survey of Interstate Route 70, made by the Department of Highways, and recorded in Volume 50, Page 65 of the Plat Records of Franklin County, Ohio, and being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the Southeast corner of said 300 acretract, and being in the Northerly right of way line of West Broad Street, said point being ho feet horth of the centeriline of West Broad Street, said point being ho feet horth of the centerilane of West Broad Street and 1349.82 feet West of the centeriline of Central Avenue. Thence North 70 hh; West along the Easterly property line of said 300 acre tract a distance of 1846.50 feet to a concrete right of way monument at the Northeast corner of said tract, said point being in the Southerly right of way line of the P. C. C. & St. L. R.R. Being a part of a 50 acre tract conveyed to the State of Ohio from William S. Sullivant by a Deed recorded in Deed Book 30, Page 516, of Franklin County Deed Records.

Beginning at the intersection of the Southerly limited access right of way line of Interstate Route 70S with the Northerly right of way line of the Penn Central Railroad (formerly C.C.C. & St. L.
