LUCAS COUNTY - THE IMPROVEMENT OF S. R. U. S. NO. 25, SECTION 2.95 GRANTED.

Pursuant to Chapter 5511 of the Revised Code of Ohio, Director Preston approved the following improvement of a portion of S. R. U. S. No. 25, Section 2.95, Lucas County, hearing having been held in Toledo, Ohio on March 3, 1960.

IMPROVEMENT OF A PORTION OF U. S. ROUTE NO. 25, SITUATED IN THE CITY OF TOLEDO AND THE CITY OF MAUMEE, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO, SAID IMPROVEMENT TO CONSIST OF WIDENING.

Said portion to be improved being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of U. S. Route No. 24, Anthony Wayne Trail, with U. S. Route No. 25, Detroit Avenue, thence northeasterly on U. S. Route No. 25, Detroit Avenue, to a point approximately 0.04 mile northeast of the intersection of U. S. Route No. 25, Detroit Avenue, with Byrne Road.

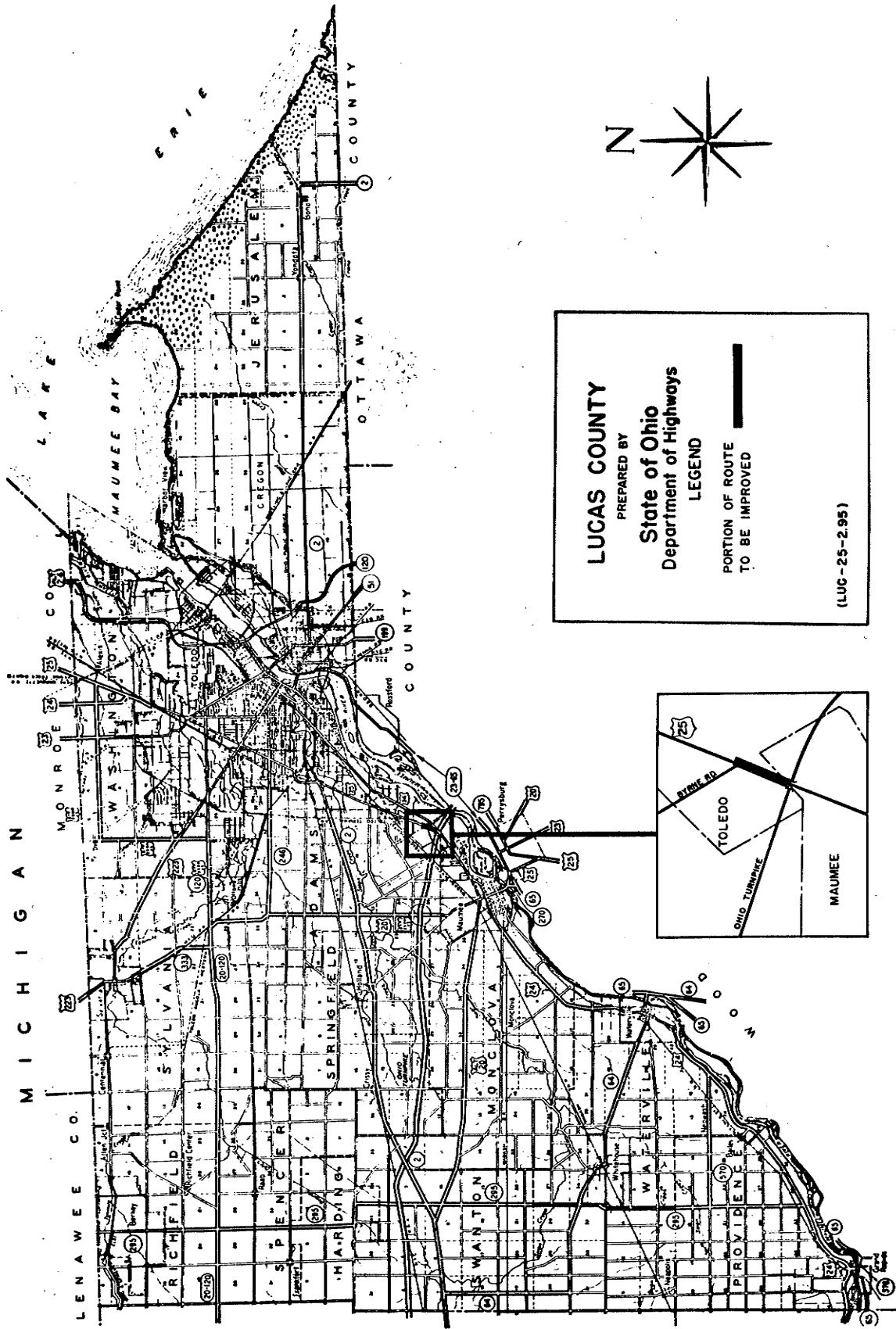
