To the commissioners of the county of Franklin in the State of Ohio.

We the undersigned Citizens of the township of Madison in the County aforesaid would represent that we labor under some inconvenience as well as the disadvantage of the location of a certain county Road petitioned for by John Courtright and others and request an alteration of the same viz. Said alteration to commence on the line between Section five & Eight, where said Road crosses said section line at the termination of a new County Road petitioned for by John Courtright & others, thence north on said half section line to the old State Road, near Beasons Blacksmith shop Sep 4th 1848. Wm. D. Needles, John Courtright, J. G. Courtright, Joseph Burkey, Eliza F. Timbrel, James Sudick, Edward Courtright, Philomon Needles, James Needles, Thomas Needles, George Needles, Abraham Swisher, N. Rarey, William S. Hopkins.

To Wm. Shannon, George White & Edward Livingston, viewers and John Cox Surveyor. You have been appointed by the board of County Commissioners to view a certain County road in Madison township, for the purpose of making an alteration therein as prayed for by William D. Needles as follows, to commence on the line between section 5 and 8. where said road crosses said Section line, at the termination of a new county road established on the petition of John Courtright and others; thence north on said half section line to the old State Road near Beasons Blacksmith shop. We the undersigned viewers appointed by the Commissioners of Franklin County to view an alteration of a county Road petitioned for by William D. Needles after having met at the house of W. D. Needles on the 26th day of January 1849 and being duly sworn proceeded to view the rout, and and do report favorable to the alteration for the following reasons; it will only increase the length of the road a little five perches and will be along the line, and will do less private damage it will intersect the old State road 57 poles further N. W. therefore decrease distance of travel from that way over 52 poles and will increase the travel the other way 62 poles that will inconvenience to the public will not be great. Wm. W. 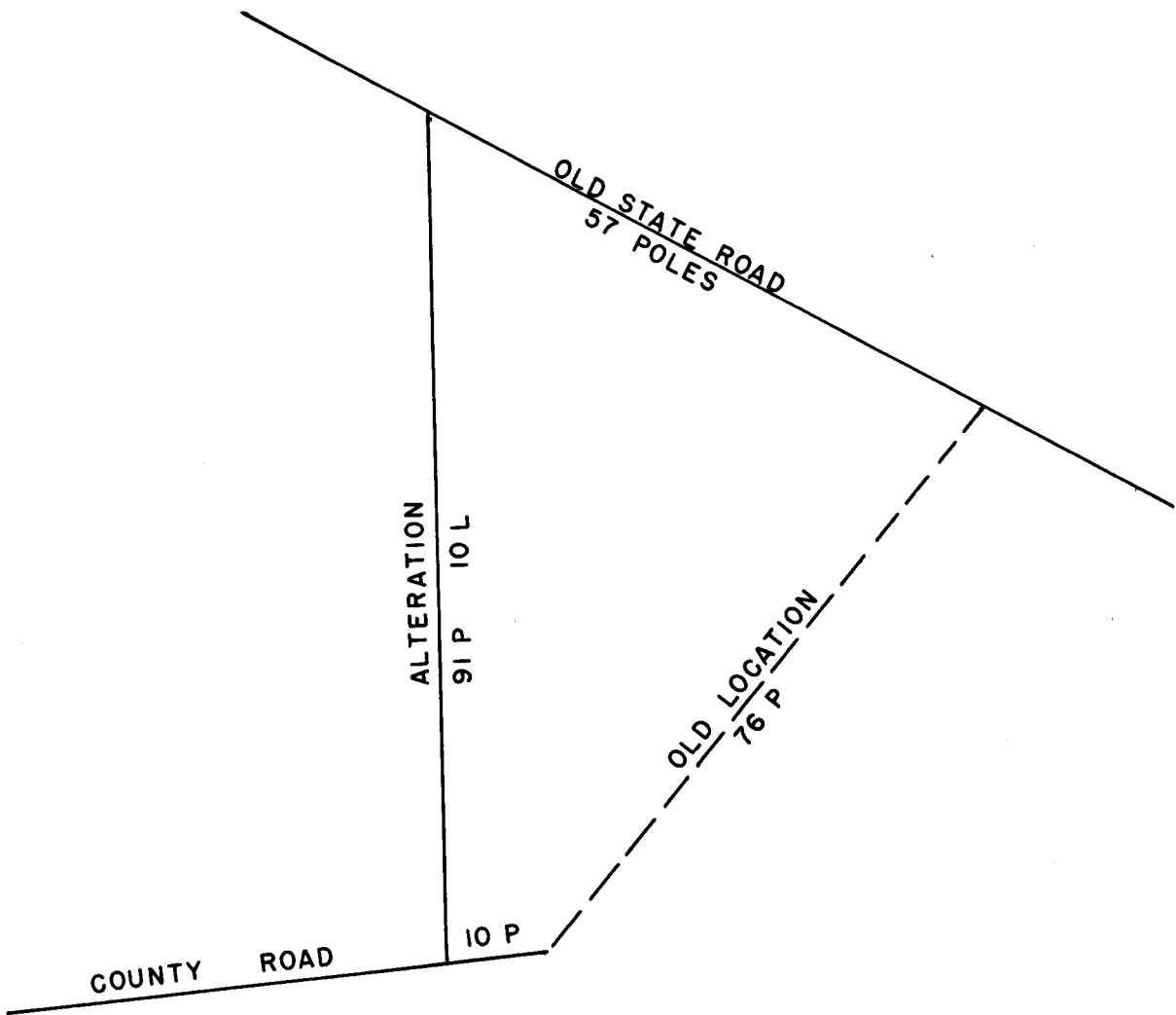
