V8i Color Table – User Documentation

Documentation:

The **ODOT_color.tbl** is the standard ODOT color table used in ODOT's plans.

Standard colors are specified to ensure consistency and to enable users to easily identify plan elements in shared files.

Each element in a MicroStation design file is assigned a color number. MicroStation reads the color table to determine the correct color to display for the specified number. Standard color numbers for plan graphics are specified in the CADD Engineering Standards Manual, Appendix A the CADD Information Table.

Notes:

- The Color Table is attached by use of the MicroStation configuration variable **MS_DEFCTBL**.
- The color values may vary or appear different on screens due to the graphics cards, monitors display capability, etc...
