- [SECTION 1302.11.2 - EARTH DISTURBED AREAS](#)  
Verbiage has been updated per the **Office of Hydraulic Engineering**. For projects involving no disturbed area, such as pavement marking, provide the estimated Project and Contractor EDA, but indicate that a Notice of Intent (NOI) is not required. For projects requiring the submittal of a Notice of Intent (NOI), list the NOI Earth Disturbed area to the tenth of an acre. More information can be found in the **Volume 2 of the L&D Manual, Section 1112**. Contact the **Office of Hydraulic Engineering** with questions.
- [SECTION 1302.15 - ADA \(AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES\) DESIGN WAIVERS](#)

- [SECTION 1307.2.3 - ITEM CODE, UNIT OF MEASURE, AND DESCRIPTION](#)  
Various updates to pay item categories. See section for details.
- [SECTION 1308.1 - GENERAL](#)  
***Important Notice*** - Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) requirements have changed. Instead of a SWPPP being required for all projects with a Project Earth Disturbed Area greater than, or equal to, one (total) acre, ***a SWPPP is now required for all projects that submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) for permit coverage under Ohio EPA's Construction General Permit.*** Contact the Office of Hydraulic Engineering directly with questions.

- **SECTION 1310.2 FORMAT**  
When existing and proposed features are located between two cross-sections, it is preferred that either additional cross-sections be included at the location of the feature, or they be shown on a storm sewer profile sheet.
- **SECTION 1312.3 - STORM SEWER PROFILES**  
Deleted 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph regarding required hydraulic information at the storm sewer outlet. Contact the **Office of Hydraulic Engineering** directly with questions.
- **SECTION 1314 - TRAFFIC CONTROL, LIGHTING, LANDSCAPING, REST AREAS, STRUCTURES, RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND SOILS INFORMATION**

- **SECTION 1314.7 - SOILS INFORMATION SHEETS**  
The title of this section has been changed to the following:  
**SOIL *PROFILE* SHEETS.**  
  
Soil profile sheets are to be prepared using the *Specifications for Geotechnical Explorations*. Additional geotechnical information, if available, may be obtained from TIMS, the *Office of Geotechnical Engineering* and/or the District Geotechnical Engineer.  
  
Include all available geotechnical information in the contract documents.
- **SECTION 1316 - SPEDUP (SIMPLIFIED PLAN - EXPEDITED DELIVERY PROJECT) PLANS**  
Section has been deleted. See above note.

## SECTION 1400 - REVIEW SUBMISSIONS
