## Maintenance Agreement

and

## The Fairless Local School District

The Village of Brewster (Village) and the Fairless Local School District (School District) have jointly participated in and have been awarded funding by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) Safe Routes to Schools Program. The funds will allow the Ohio Department of Transportation under project STA US62-5.10 SRTS, PID 110990 to install the following improvements on School District property:

- Construct shared use path along US62 connecting Fairless Elementary School to Fairless Middle School
- Install bike racks at both schools

A requirement of the ODOT Safe Routes to Schools Program requires the Village and School District to develop a maintenance plan for the proposed project. Therefore, the Village and School District agree to the following maintenance plan:

The School District will maintain the items listed above by performing routine maintenance and needed repairs.

The agreement shall be in effect from the date signed by the last party and shall be in effect for a period of 25 years. The parties provide that this agreement is renewable for additional years if agreed by both parties.

The Village and School District hold each other harmless from any liability that may arise in the normal course of maintenance and repairs.
