REMARKS: Deeds, Vol. 1119, Page 311 Rec. 11-15-1943

Wm. H. Gould being first duly sworn according to law deposes and says that he is a civil engineer and surveyor of thirty years experience: that in the year 1920 at the request of a large number of the abutting land owners upon the canal between Maumee and Toledo, and under the direction of the Superintendent of Public Works of the State of Ohio, and in conjunction with Mr. E.E. Booton, representing the Superintendent of Public Works of Ohio, he made a survey of the land abutting on said canal between Clark Avenue and Maumee, Ohio, and in arriving at an agreement as to the proper boundaries of the canal, he, in conjunction with the said Mr. E.E. Booton, and by authority of Section 13964 of the Revised Statutes of Ohio, made a careful and extensive investigation of the needs of the State for canal purposes and the rights of owners of property abutting on the canal from the City of Toledo through Maumee, and fixed upon a uniform width of the canal lands of one hundred and thirty-five (135) feet measured twenty-five (25) feet northwesterly at right angles to the transit line as set Mr. S.A. Buchanan, and in the opposite direction from said line one hundred and ten (110) feet making a strip of around one hundred thirty-five (135) feet in width; and it was agreed that this would be the limit of the State's requirements for canal purpose through the territory named.

This survey was approved by the Superintendent of Public Works of the State of Ohio on the 2nd day of February, 1920.
