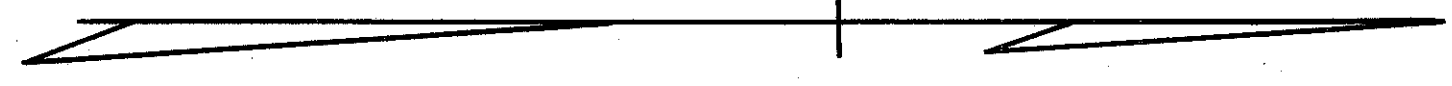


SEC. 36 TOWN 3 N RANGE 10 E HENRY TOWNSHIP

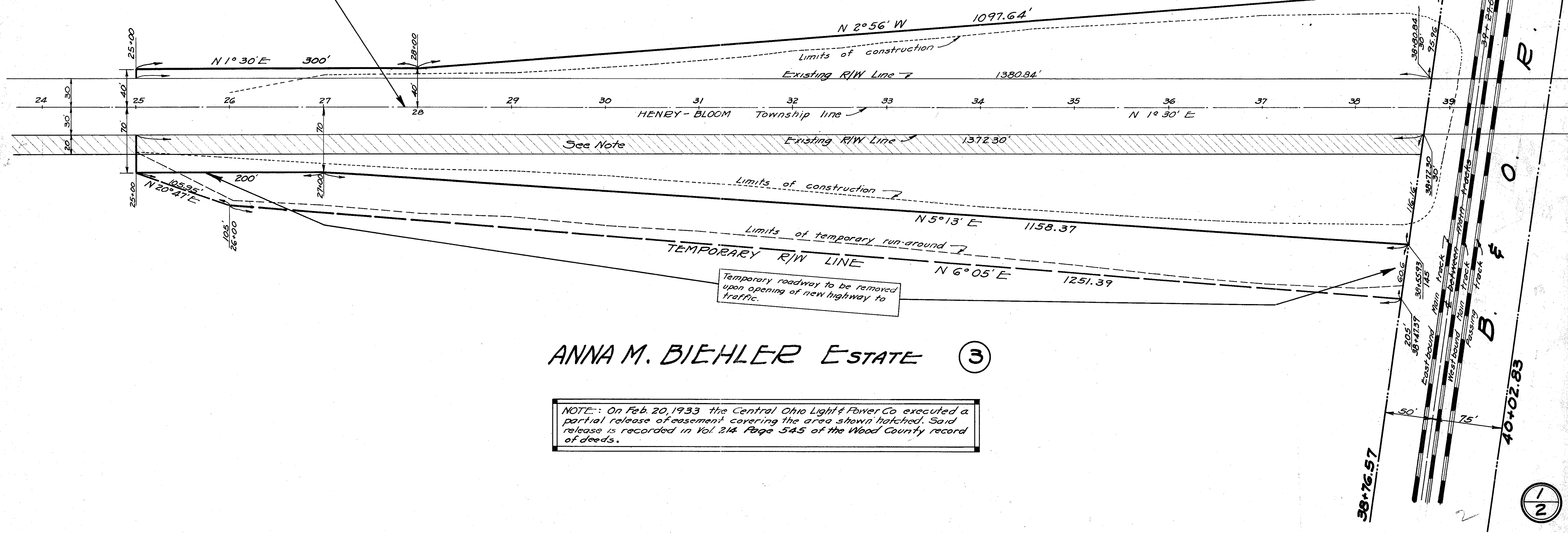
Beginning of Sec. F2 (E of S.H. 224, State Route # 18) is at Sta 17+83 or 1003 south of the beginning of this project.

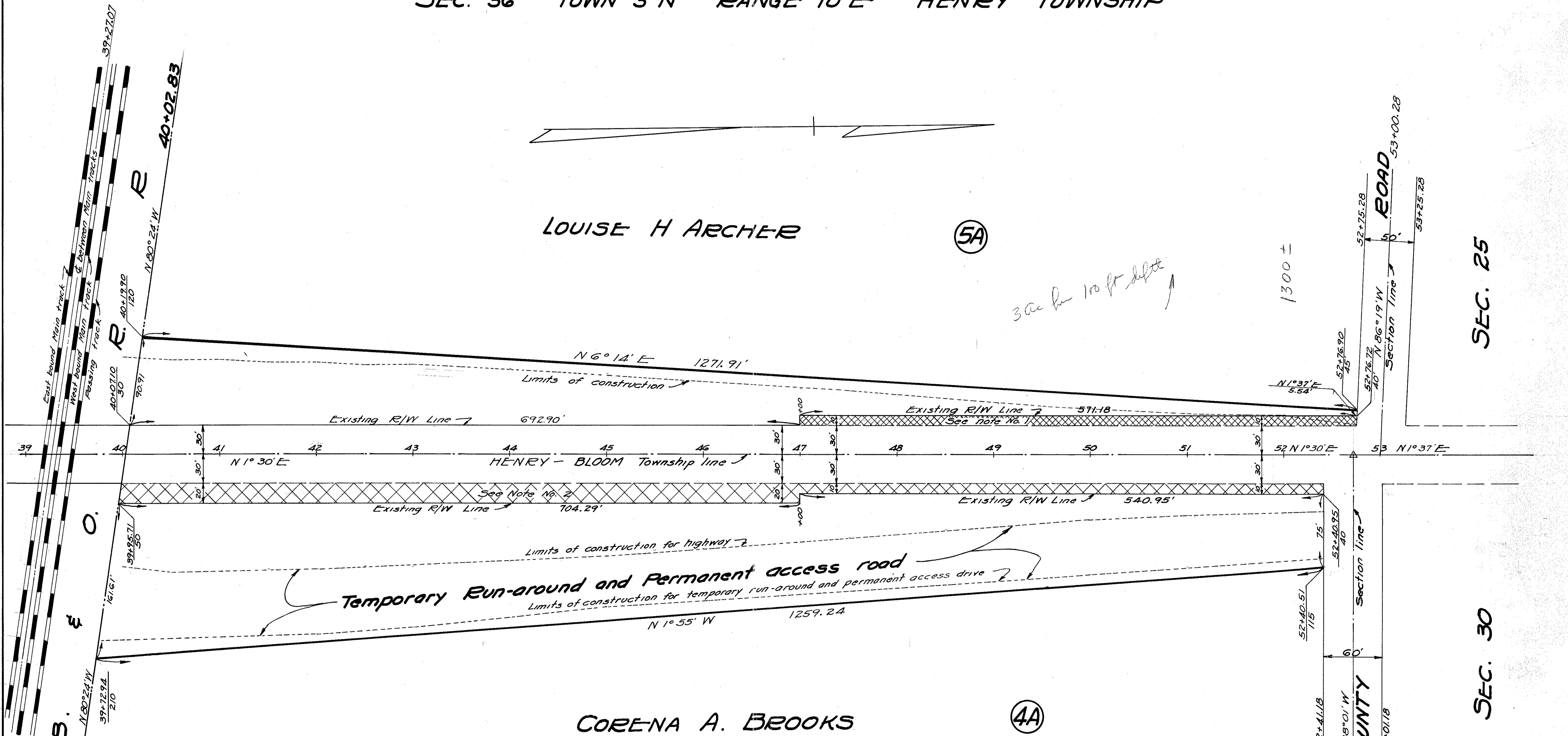
