This cause came on to be heard on the 13th day of November, 1979, upon Plaintiff's notice to the Court submitted on October 19, 1979, advising that Plaintiff wished to purchase parcel number five, the Sohio parcel upon the terms set forth in said notice. 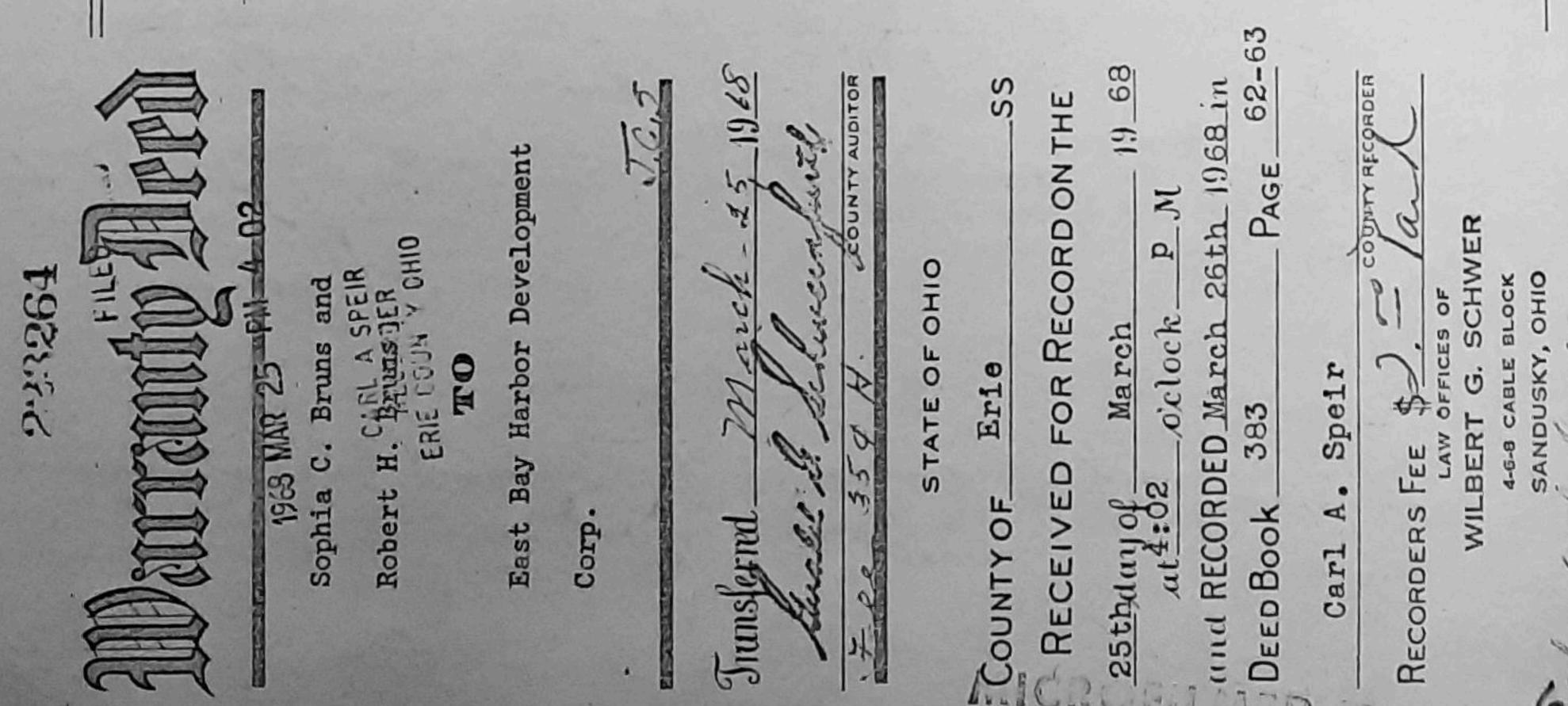

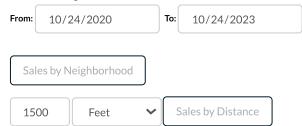

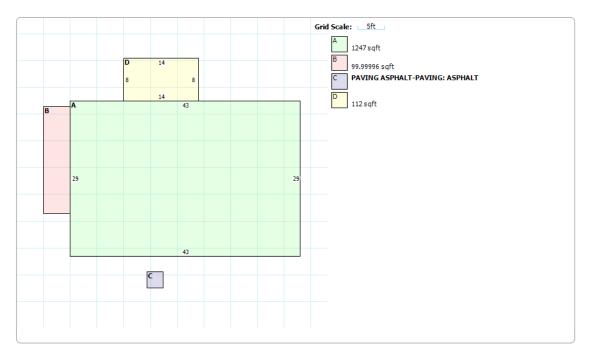
