**Project Description**

The City of Cambridge is seeking to repair and replace 1697.4 linear feet of sidewalk along S. 11th Street. This corridor is currently the primary pedestrian access between downtown and business/services on the south side. Due to the closure of the Southgate Parkway bridge, which is being fully reconstructed, there is no viable alternative for pedestrians. The project will remove 8517 square feet of existing but deficient sidewalk. During construction some of the curb may need to be replaced to maintain drainage. There is evidence of pedestrians currently using this pathway, even without adequate infrastructure.

South 11th Street / Woodlawn Avenue is a primary detour route connecting downtown Cambridge to the south side of the city. This route has a lower speed limit than Southgate Parkway and is often used by pedestrians during all seasons. With the reconstruction of the Southgate Parkway Bridge the AADT has nearly doubled. People with limited mobility are often forced to walk or use their scooter in the motorized traffic lanes.
