This corridor is currently the primary pedestrian access between downtown and business/services on the south side. Due to the closure of the Southgate Parkway bridge, which is being fully reconstructed, there is no viable alternative for pedestrians. The project will remove 8517 square feet of existing but deficient sidewalk. During construction some of the curb may need to be replaced to maintain drainage. There is evidence of pedestrians currently using this pathway, even without adequate infrastructure.
