In Spring 2025, improvements will begin in downtown Granville on Broadway from Main Street to Pearl Street. The project will bring with it improvements to both pedestrian safety and traffic congestion; as well as environmentally-friendly streetscape beautification. This document is to encourage the thoughtful sharing of information and to inform community members of the project extents.

Crucial traffic and pedestrian safety upgrades in Downtown Granville will get underway in April 2025. Over the last seven years, the Village has worked diligently to secure funding from multiple sources through partnerships with Licking County Area Transportation Study (LCATS) and Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT). By late fall 2025, residents and visitors will experience a safer, more pedestrian-friendly, downtown.

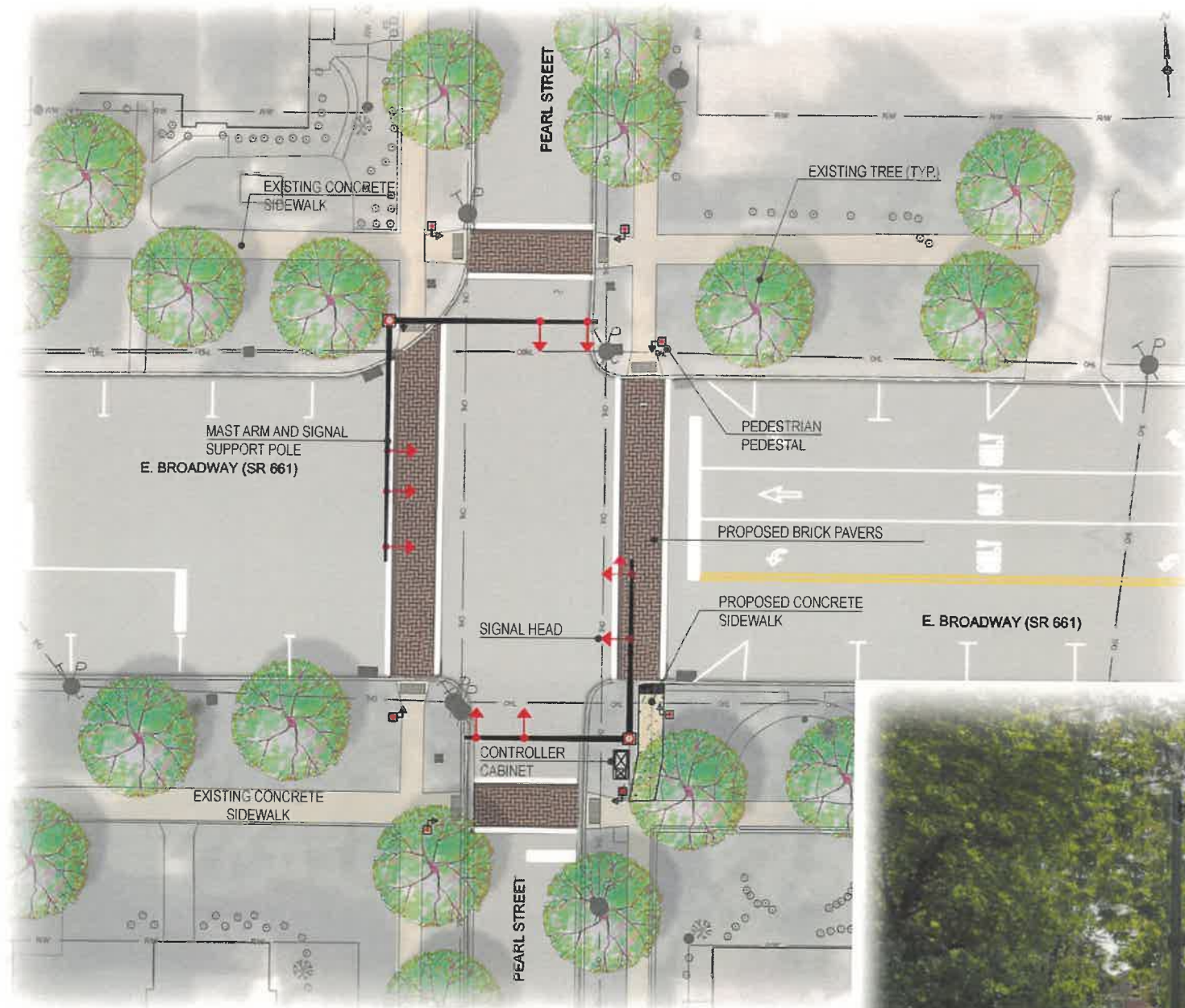
PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

- Curb bump-outs will be installed where feasible to shorten crossing distances, increase pedestrian visibility to traffic, and reduce vehicular speeds.
- ADA compliance will be improved with the installation of push-button activated walk signals.
- Pedestrian visibility will be upgraded with improved lighting in crosswalks, an in-pavement blinking light system, and contrasting brick pavers and pavement markings.
