Local Entity: Village of Granville, Ohio

Project Location: Newark-Granville Road at 785 Newark-Granville Road to Thornwood Crossing Intersection - North Side of Newark-Granville Road

Project Type: Active Transportation; Resurfacing of Multi-Use Path Along Newark-Granville Road

Description of Project: Resurfacing of Newark-Granville Road Multi-use Path - approximately 1.7 miles @10' width. Anticipated to be 1"-2" Mill & Fill

Purpose and need/ Other comments: A critical Granville Active Transportation Plan element, the Newark-Granville Road multi-use path serves as the backbone of pedestrian and cyclist movement serving the east side of the Village. Well-utilized since its installation decades ago, it's current state/condition is starting to present safety concerns for users. Approximately two years ago, a wheelchair bound resident, rather than utilize the deteriorating path, chose to use the travel lanes of Newark-Granville Road. A choice we don't want anyone to make.
