To all whom these presents shall come: Whereas on the 9th day of May AD 1891, Rufus M. Daw, filed his petition in the Court of Common Pleas within and for the County of Muskingum and State of Ohio, against Elizabeth Daw, and others demanding Partition of certain real Estate herein-after described, and whereas such proceedings were had upon said Petition that Commissioners duly appointed by said Court to make Partition of said Real Estate made report that Partition of the same could not be made without manifest injury, and that the value thereof was One hundred Dollars subject to the life Estate of said Elizabeth Daw and whereas, at the April Term of said Court 1891, the said report of said Commissioners was approved and confirmed by said Court, and the said Eunice Roberts, a defendant herein electing to take said Real Estate at the value of said Commissioners and having paid to the said Plaintiff, Rufus M. Daw and to said defendants Elizabeth Daw and others their respective proportions of the appraised value thereof, the said Court did adjudge said Estate to the said Eunice Roberts and did order the Sheriff to execute a deed in fee simple for the same to said Eunice Roberts all of which will more fully appear, by reference to the records of said Court, now therefore I William H.
