#### **Project Description**

The Village of Philo is seeking to connect the village sidewalk network to the newly constructed bridge across the Muskingum River at the intersection of Bridge Street and Old River Road just north of the village. The project would begin at 1st Street and Front Street and terminate at the intersection of Bridge Street and Old River Road. The total length is approximately 860 linear feet.

Village residents currently use this unimproved pathway to access Duncan Falls (an unincorporated area in Wayne Township, Muskingum County, Ohio) immediately across the bridge. Duncan Falls is located along State Route 60 and has more abundant commerical services than the Village of Philo. The Franklin Local School campus is also located in Duncan Falls, and students have been reported using this pathway to access the campus.
