

**VILLAGE OF PHILO
RESOLUTION #2023-7.2**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF PHILO TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside monies for the Transportation Alternatives Program through the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT);

WHEREAS, the Village of Philo wishes to apply to the ODOT Transportation Alternatives Program for the Village to River Access Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village to River Access Project is an eligible activity under the ODOT Transportation Alternatives Program by providing safe pedestrian and bicycle facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PHILO, MUSKINGUM COUNTY, OHIO:


- (1) The Mayor of the Village of Philo is hereby authorized to apply to the ODOT Transportation Alternatives Program for the Village to River Access Project.
- (2) The Mayor of the Village of Philo is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
- (3) The total construction cost of the project is approximately \$130,855, which includes construction engineering. This amount may change contingent upon ODOT approval. If awarded funds, the Village of Philo commits up to 5% of the actual cost for construction. The local share for construction costs is estimated to be \$6,642.75 and shall be funded through the Village of Philo's General Operating Funds.
- (4) This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- (5) This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Philo, Ohio and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
