Beginning at a stone found at the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4; thence North 00 Degrees 00 Minutes 00 Seconds West 1453.59 feet to an iron pin found and the place of beginning; thence continuing along said line North 00 Degrees 00 Minutes 00 Seconds West 724.77 feet to an iron pin found; thence North 70 Degrees 37 Minutes 27 Seconds East 256.91 feet to an iron pin set; thence North 17 Degrees 05 Minutes 34 Seconds West 304.14 feet to an iron pin found; thence South 78 Degrees 10 Minutes 38 Seconds West 156.28 feet to an iron pin set on the Mid Line; thence along said line North 00 Degrees 00 Minutes 00 Seconds East 122.64 feet to a railroad spike set in the centerline of Twp.
