Good Afternoon Jared,

As per our earlier phone conversation could you please provide the answers to the following questions below.

- Number of vehicles in and out of each drive daily I guess you could assume 46 vehicles at the main entrance per day (but not at same time), plus any customers that may visit the facility per day.
- Their utility trucks would be the only vehicles entering and exiting the west entrance....and they have 6 utility trucks. Number of total employees working at this location 46 employees
- Typically ODOT only allows for one access point per parcel, please explain the reasoning for the need of more than one access point. The main entrance located at the intersection of HWY 50 and HWY 753 will be utilized for the public and employees.
 - We are proposing a separate entrance for their utility trucks and delivery use, to help separate/accommodate the safety of the public traffic. This will also provide another option for any utility truck traffic directed north (to 312) which will reduce any utility trucks needing to access HWY 50, only to turn off on another road a mile down. This access road to the north (connecting to 312) will help reduce utility truck traffic on HWY 50.
- The submitted drive request form state the speed limit is 45 mph at this location. The speed limit is actually 55 mph, could you please resubmit the new drive request form with the updated speed limit. I missed that, guess I was looking at an old posted speed limit sign? Please see attached for revised
