ODOT is presently installing a four way stop with flashers at this intersection.

Conclusions

It can be seen from the counts shown above that the traffic on SR 124 is anticipated to basically stay the same when the interchange for SR 32/ SR 327 is built.

Because of the four way stop that is being installed at the SR 124/ SR 327 intersection the speeds of the traffic in the vicinity of this intersection will be significantly less.
