The Bureau of Traffic has reviewed the traffic engineering study for the subject location and hereby offers the following comments:

The submitted study is not complete. In order for the study to be complete, the following information must also be provided: an existing conditions diagram, pictures of the intersection, and a traffic accident analysis for the previous three-year period.

The recommendations proposed in the submitted study, which consists of the installation of an intersection control beacon in conjunction with the elimination of the through movements across US 23, appear to be extreme for an intersection which is not even eligible to be listed on the 1992 Highway Safety Program Listing.

We are requesting that you resubmit the subject traffic engineering study containing the aforementioned information so that we may more accurately analyze the current traffic conditions at this location.
