ITEM 614 - LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER (WITH PATROL CAR) FOR ASSISTANCE DURING **CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS**

USE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS (LEOS) BY CONTRACTORS OTHER THAN THE USES SPECIFIED BELOW WILL NOT BE PERMITTED AT PROJECT COST. LEOS SHOULD NOT BE USED WHERE THE OMUTCD INTENDS THAT FLAGGERS BE USED.

IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF C&MS 614 AND THE OMUTCD, A UNIFORMED LEO WITH AN OFFICIAL PATROL CAR (CAR WITH TOP-MOUNTED EMERGENCY FLASHING LIGHTS AND COMPLETE MARKINGS OF THE APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY) SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR THE FOLLOWING TRAFFIC CONTROL TASKS:

- * DURING THE ENTIRE ADVANCE PREPARATION AND CLOSURE SEQUENCE WHERE COMPLETE BLOCKAGE OF TRAFFIC IS REQUIRED.
- * DURING A TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION WHEN IMPACTING THE NORMAL FUNCTION OF THE SIGNAL OR THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC, OR WHEN TRAFFIC NEEDS TO BE DIRECTED THROUGH AN ENERGIZED TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTRARY TO THE SIGNAL DISPLAY (E.G., DIRECTING MOTORISTS THROUGH A RED LIGHT).

IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENT OF C&MS 614 AND THE OMUTCD, A UNIFORMED LEO WITH AN OFFICIAL PATROL CAR (CAR WITH TOP-MOUNTED EMERGENCY FLASHING LIGHTS AND COMPLETE MARKINGS OF THE APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY) SHOULD BE PROVIDED FOR THE FOLLOWING TRAFFIC CONTROL TASKS AS APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER:

- * FOR LANE CLOSURES: DURING INITIAL SET-UP PERIODS, TEAR DOWN PERIODS, SUBSTANTIAL SHIFTS OF A CLOSURE POINT OR WHEN NEW LANE CLOSURE ARRANGEMENTS ARE INITIATED FOR LONG-TERM LANE CLOSURES/ SHIFTS (FOR THE FIRST AND LAST DAY OF MAJOR CHANGES IN TRAFFIC CONTROL SETUP).
- * FOR OPERATIONS WITHOUT POSITIVE PROTECTION OCCURRING WITHIN 10 FEET OF AN OPEN TRAVELED LANE THAT MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:
 - * ON A MULTI-LANE DIVIDED INTERSTATE. OTHER FREEWAY OR EXPRESSWAY; AND
 - * AN AUTHORIZED SPEED LIMIT OF 45 MPH OR GREATER THAT IS IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF THE OPERATION; AND,
 - * AADT OF 50,000 (OR AADT OF 30,000 WITH 25% OR HIGHER PERCENT TRUCKS)

"WITHOUT POSITIVE PROTECTION" MEANS USE OF DRUMS, CONES, SHADOW VEHICLE, ETC, WITHOUT PROTECTION FROM PORTABLE BARRIER OR OTHER RIGID BARRIER ALONG THE WORK AREA. THIS PHRASE DOES NOT APPLY TO CASES WHERE POSITIVE PROTECTION IS REQUIRED. MOBILE OPERATIONS ARE REGARDED AS "WITHOUT POSITIVE PROTECTION". FOR WORK ZONES USING A COMBINATION OF BARRIER AND TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (CONES, DRUMS, ETC), THE DESIGNATION SHALL BE BASED UPON THE TYPE OF DEVICES USED IN THE AREA THAT WORKERS ARE LOCATED.

IF MULTIPLE ACTIVE LOCALIZED QUALIFYING WORK AREAS OCCUR WITHOUT POSITIVE PROTECTION. PER MAINLINE TRAFFIC DIRECTION. PROVIDE A UNIFORMED **LEO** AND OFFICIAL PATROL CAR IN ADVANCE OF:

- * THE FIRST ACTIVE WORK AREA THAT DRIVERS WILL ENCOUNTER; OR
- * THE ACTIVE WORK AREA LATERALLY CLOSEST TO THE OPEN TRAVELED LANE; OR
- * OTHER LOCATION AS APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.

THE UNIFORMED **LEO** AND OFFICIAL PATROL CAR MAY RELOCATE AMONG THE LISTED LOCATIONS AS APPROPRIATE AS THE OPERATIONS PROCEED IN THE LOCALIZED QUALIFYING WORK AREAS.

IN GENERAL, LEOS SHOULD BE POSITIONED IN ADVANCE OF AND ON THE SAME SIDE AS THE LANE RESTRICTION (OR AT THE POINT OF ROAD CLOSURE), AND TO MANUALLY CONTROL TRAFFIC MOVEMENTS THROUGH SIGNALIZED INTERSECTIONS IN WORK ZONES.

LEOS SHOULD NOT FORGO THEIR TRAFFIC CONTROL RESPONSIBILITIES TO APPREHEND MOTORISTS FOR ROUTINE TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS. HOWEVER, IF A MOTORIST'S ACTIONS ARE CONSIDERED TO BE RECKLESS, THEN PURSUIT OF THE MOTORIST IS APPROPRIATE.

THE LEOS WORK AT THE DIRECTION OF THE CONTRACTOR. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SECURING THE SERVICES OF THE LEOS WITH THE APPROPRIATE AGENCIES AND COMMUNICATING THE INTENTIONS OF THE PLANS WITH RESPECT TO DUTIES OF THE LEOS. THE ENGINEER SHALL HAVE FINAL CONTROL OVER THE LEOS' DUTIES AND PLACEMENT, AND WILL RESOLVE ANY ISSUES THAT MAY ARISE BETWEEN THE TWO PARTIES.

ENSURE PROVIDED LEOS HAVE BEEN TRAINED APPROPRIATE TO THE JOB DECISIONS THEY ARE REQUIRED TO MAKE WHILE ON THE PROJECT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH C&MS 614.03.

ITEM 614 - LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER (WITH PATROL CAR) FOR ASSISTANCE DURING CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS (CONT.)

THE **LEO** SHALL REPORT IN TO THE CONTRACTOR PRIOR TO THE START OF THE SHIFT. IN ORDER TO RECEIVE INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING SPECIFIC WORK ASSIGNMENTS DURING HIS/HER SHIFT. THE **LEO** IS EXPECTED TO STAY AT THE PROJECT SITE FOR THE ENTIRE DURATION OF HIS/HER SHIFT. THE **LEO** SHALL REPORT TO THE CONTRACTOR AT THE END OF HIS/HER SHIFT. SHOULD IT BE NECESSARY TO LEAVE THE PROJECT SITE, THE LEO SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE THE **LEO** WITH A TWO-WAY COMMUNICATION DEVICE THAT SHALL BE RETURNED TO THE CONTRACTOR AT THE END OF HIS/HER SHIFT.

LEOS (WITH PATROL CAR) REQUIRED BY THE TRAFFIC MAINTENANCE TASKS ABOVE SHALL BE PAID FOR ON A UNIT PRICE (HOURLY) BASIS UNDER ITEM 614, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER (WITH PATROL CAR) FOR ASSISTANCE. THE FOLLOWING ESTIMATED QUANTITIES HAVE BEEN CARRIED TO THE SUBSUMMARY.

ITEM 614, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WITH PATROL CAR FOR ASSISTANCE 50 HOURS

THE HOURS PAID SHALL INCLUDE ANY MINIMUM SHOW-UP TIME REQUIRED BY THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY INVOLVED. ANY ADDITIONAL COSTS (ADMINISTRATIVE OR OTHERWISE) INCURRED BY THE CONTRACTOR TO OBTAIN THE SERVICES OF AN **LEO** ARE INCLUDED WITH THE BID UNIT PRICE FOR ITEM 614, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WITH PATROL CAR FOR ASSISTANCE.

ITEM 614 - DETOUR SIGNING

SIZE AND PLACEMENT OF DETOUR SIGNS (M4-9) SHOULD FOLLOW THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE OMUTCD SECTION 6F.03, SECTION 2A.11 AND TABLE 6F.01.

DETOUR SIGNING SHALL PROVIDE DRIVERS ADEQUATE TIME TO CLEARLY READ THE SIGNS AND MAKE THE PROPER DECISIONS AT EACH REQUIRED TURNING MOVEMENT. THE DESIGNATED DETOUR ROUTE SHALL BE SIGNED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS BELOW: * AT OR NEAR THE EXISTING LANE ASSIGNMENT SIGN AT AN INTERSECTION.

- * EVERY TWO BLOCKS ALONG A TANGENT SECTION BETWEEN TURNING MOVEMENTS WITHIN A CITY.
- * AT ANY OTHER INTERSECTION OR DECISION POINT WHERE THE DETOUR ROUTE IS CONTRARY TO THE NORMAL, EXPECTED TURNING MANEUVER OR OTHERWISE UNCLEAR.

DETOUR SIGNS SHALL BE PLACED, WHEN POSSIBLE, NEXT TO BUT NOT BLOCKING EXISTING ROUTE MARKERS OR LANE ASSIGNMENT SIGNS. DETOUR SIGNS SHALL NOT OBSCURE OR BE OBSCURED BY OTHER **EXISTING OR TEMPORARY SIGNS.**

DETOUR SIGNS SHALL BE ERECTED AND/OR UNCOVERED PRIOR TO THE ROAD OR RAMP BEING CLOSED TO TRAFFIC BUT NO EARLIER THAN FOUR HOURS PRIOR TO THE CLOSURE. DETOUR SIGNS SHALL BE COVERED AND/OR REMOVED NO LATER THAN FOUR HOURS FOLLOWING THE ROAD OR RAMP RE-OPENING TO TRAFFIC.

PAYMENT FOR ACCEPTED QUANTITIES WILL BE MADE AT THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICE, PAYMENT SHALL BE FOR ALL MATERIALS, LABOR. INCIDENTALS AND EQUIPMENT FOR FURNISHING, PROPER SIGN PLACEMENT AND SIZING, TIMELY ERECTING AND/OR UNCOVERING OF SIGNS, MAINTAINING SIGNS, AND TIMELY COVERING AND/OR REMOVING SIGNS AND SUPPORTS.

THE FOLLOWING ESTIMATED QUANTITIES HAVE BEEN CARRIED TO THE GENERAL SUMMARY.

ITEM 614 - DETOUR SIGNING = LUMP SUM

NOTIFICATION OF CONSTRUCTION INITIATION

TWO (2) WEEKS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE SERVICE PROGRAM MANAGER OF THE CENTRAL OHIO TRANSIT AUTHORITY (COTA) AT PHONE # (614) 308-4373 OR E-MAIL AT EVANSPM1@COTA.COM TO COORDINATE PROPER BUS MOVEMENTS THROUGH OR AROUND THE JOBSITE DURING THE PROJECT. THIS WILL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE TEMPORARY RELOCATION OR REMOVAL OF COTA SIGNS.

COORDINATION WITH ADJACENT PROJECTS

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WORK WITH ODOT AND THE CONTRACTORS ON THE ADJACENT PROJECTS (PID 95369 AND PID 109014). COORDINATION SHALL BE MADE TO PREVENT CONFLICTING ADVANCE WARNING SIGNS, CONFLICTING DETOUR ROUTES, OVERLAPPING/CONFLICTING LANE CLOSURES, AND TO ENSURE THAT A MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 2 MILES BETWEEN ADJACENT LANE CLOSURES IS MAINTAINED. THIS IS NOT AN EXHAUSTIVE LIST OF COORDINATION ITEMS THAT MAY NEED TO BE RESOLVED BETWEEN PROJECTS. THE DEPARTMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DECIDE WHICH PROJECT'S ACTIVITIES TAKE PRECEDENCE. PROJECTS THAT HAVE ACTIVITIES DELAYED DUE TO CONFLICTS WILL CONSIDER THIS AN EXCUSABLE, NON-COMPENSABLE DELAY PER 108.06.B. ON PROJECTS THAT HAVE ACTIVITIES DELAYED DUE TO CONFLICTS WHERE THE CONTRACTOR FAILED TO MEET THE NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS, THE DELAYS SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED EXCUSABLE OR COMPENSABLE.

ATTENDANCE AT DEPARTMENT ORDERED TRAFFIC COORDINATION MEETINGS BETWEEN ADJACENT PROJECTS SHALL BE CONSIDERED MANDATORY FOR EACH PROJECT'S SUPERINTENDENT, AND SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO THE LUMP SUM MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC PAYMENT ITEM.

NOTIFICATION OF CONSTRUCTION INITIATION

AT LEAST FOURTEEN DAYS PRIOR TO STARTING INITIAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADVISE THE DISTRICT OFFICE OF COMMUNICATIONS VIA EMAIL AT D06.PIO@DOT.OHIO.GOV, THE DISTRICT WORK ZONE TRAFFIC MANAGER VIA EMAIL AT D06.MOT@DOT. OHIO.GOV AND THE CENTRAL OFFICE SPECIAL HAUL PERMITS SECTION VIA EMAIL AT HAULING.PERMITS@ DOT.OHIO.GOV OF THE ANTICIPATED START DATE OF ANY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE PLACING OF WORK ZONE SIGNS. THE NOTIFICATION SHALL ALSO INCLUDE THE PROJECT NUMBER, PID, NAME AND PHONE NUMBER OF THE CONTRACTOR, A POINT OF CONTACT AND THE ANTICIPATED IMPACT ON TRAFFIC. THE CONTRACTOR WILL IMMEDIATELY INFORM THE DISTRICT OFFICE OF COMMUNICATIONS AND THE DISTRICT WORK ZONE TRAFFIC MANAGER OF ANY AND ALL DELAYS AND/OR CHANGES REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION INITIATION DATE.

ITEM 900 - RAILROAD FLAGGING SERVICES

FLAGGING FOR WORK ON RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY SHALL BE COORDINATED, OBTAINED AND PAID FOR BY THE CONTRACTOR. FLAGGING SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE CONTRACTOR WHENEVER REQUIRED BY THE NORFOLK SOUTHERN SPECIAL PROVISION FOR THE PROTECTION OF RAILWAY INTERESTS (SECTION 7.A.2). NORFOLK SOUTHERN SHALL APPROVE THE FLAGGING SERVICE PROVIDER AND THEIR STAFF.

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NORFOLK SOUTHERN HAS THE SOLE AUTHORITY TO DETERMINE THE NEED FOR PROTECTIVE SERVICES TO PROTECT ITS OPERATIONS. IN GENERAL THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUCH SERVICES WILL BE WHENEVER CONTRACTORS PERSONNEL OR EQUIPMENT ARE OR ARE LIKELY TO BE WORKED ON THE RAILROADS RIGHT-OF-WAY OR ACROSS, OVER, ADJACENT TO, OR UNDER A TRACK, OR WHEN SUCH WORK HAS DISTURBED OR IS LIKELY TO DISTURB A RAILROAD STRUCTURE OR THE RAILWAY ROADBED OR SURFACE AND ALIGNMENT OF ANY TRACK TO SUCH EXTENT THAT OF TRAINS MUST CONTROLLED BY FLAGGING.

PAYMENT PER DAY FOR ITEM 900 RAILROAD FLAGGING SERVICES SHALL INCLUDE ALL COSTS OF THE FLAGGING SERVICE, INCLUDING ANY CONTRACTOR OVERHEAD FOR ADMINISTRATING THE CONTRACT WITH THE FLAGGING SERVICE.

PORTABLE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH, INSTALL, MAINTAIN AND REMOVE, WHEN NO LONGER NEEDED. A CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGN. THE SIGN SHALL BE OF A TYPE SHOWN ON A LIST OF APPROVED PCMS UNITS AVAILABLE ON THE OFFICE OF MATERIALS MANAGEMENT WEB PAGE. THE LIST CONTAINS CLASS A AND B UNITS WITH MINIMUM LEGIBILITY DISTANCES OF 800 FEET AND 650 FEET, RESPECTIVELY.

EACH SIGN SHALL BE TRAILER-MOUNTED AND EQUIPPED WITH A FUNCTIONAL DIMMING MECHANISM. TO DIM THE SIGN DURING DARKNESS. AND A TAMPER AND VANDAL PROOF ENCLOSURE. EACH SIGN SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH APPROPRIATE TRAINING AND OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS TO ENABLE ON-SITE PERSONNEL TO OPERATE AND TROUBLE-SHOOT THE UNIT. THE SIGN SHALL ALSO BE CAPABLE OF BEING POWERED BY AN ELECTRICAL SERVICE DROP FROM A LOCAL UTILITY COMPANY. THE PCMS SHALL BE DELINEATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH C&MS 614.03.

THE PROBABLE PCMS LOCATIONS AND WORK LIMITS FOR THOSE LOCATIONS SHALL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. PLACEMENT OPERATION. MAINTENANCE AND ALL ACTIVATION OF THE SIGNS BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. THE PCMS SHALL BE LOCATED IN A HIGHLY VISIBLE POSITION YET PROTECTED FROM TRAFFIC. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL, AT THE DIRECTION OF THE ENGINEER, RELOCATE THE PCMS TO IMPROVE VISIBILITY OR ACCOMMODATE CHANGED CONDITIONS. WHEN NOT IN USE, THE PCMS SHALL BE TURNED OFF. ADDITIONALLY, WHEN NOT IN USE FOR EXTENDED PERIODS OF TIME. THE PCMS SHALL BE TURNED AWAY FROM ALL TRAFFIC.

THE ENGINEER SHALL BE PROVIDED ACCESS TO EACH SIGN UNIT AND SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH APPROPRIATE TRAINING AND OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS TO ENABLE ODOT PERSONNEL TO OPERATE AND TROUBLESHOOT THE UNIT. AND TO REVISE SIGN MESSAGES, IF **NECESSARY**

ALL MESSAGES TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE SIGN WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE ENGINEER. A LIST OF ALL REQUIRED PRE-PROGRAMMED MESSAGES WILL BE GIVEN TO THE CONTRACTOR AT THE PROJECT PRE-CONSTRUCTION CONFERENCE. THE SIGN SHALL HAVE THE CAPABILITY TO STORE UP TO 99 MESSAGES. MESSAGE MEMORY OR PRE-PROGRAMMED DISPLAYS SHALL NOT BE LOST AS A RESULT OF POWER FAILURES TO THE ON-BOARD COMPUTER. THE SIGN LEGEND SHALL BE CAPABLE OF BEING CHANGED IN THE FIELD. THREE-LINE PRESENTATION FORMATS WITH UP TO SIX MESSAGE PHASES SHALL BE SUPPORTED. PCMS FORMAT SHALL PERMIT THE COMPLETE MESSAGE FOR EACH PHASE TO BE READ AT LEAST TWICE.

THE PCMS SHALL CONTAIN AN ACCURATE CLOCK AND PROGRAMMING LOGIC WHICH WILL ALLOW THE SIGN TO BE ACTIVATED, DEACTIVATED OR MESSAGES CHANGED AUTOMATICALLY AT DIFFERENT TIMES OF THE DAY FOR DIFFERENT DAYS OF THE WEEK.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR 24-HOUR-PER-DAY OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THESE SIGNS ON THE PROJECT FOR THE DURATION OF THE PHASES WHEN THE PLAN REQUIRES THEIR USE.

WHEN USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH STANDARD DRAWING MT-99.60. PAYMENT FOR THE ABOVE DESCRIBED ITEM SHALL CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO ITEM 614. MAINTAINING TRAFFIC.
