MAINTAIN ALL EXISTING LANES OF TRAFFIC AT ALL TIME, EXCEPT LANE CLOSURES THAT ARE PERMITTED PER THE LANE VALUE CONTRACT TBALE AND THE MOT POLICY EXCEPTION NOTE, BY USE OF THE EXISTING AND THE COMPLETED PAVEMENT.

MAINTAIN A MINIMUM OF THE EXISTING DECISION SIGHT DISTANCE AT EACH ENTRANCE RAMP.

NO WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED AND ALL EXISTING LANES SHALL BE OPEN TO TRAFFIC DURING THE FOLLOWING DESIGNATED HOLIDAYS OR SPECIAL EVENTS:

NEW YEAR'S (OBSERVED) GENERAL/REGULAR ELECTION DAY ((NOV) THANKSGIVING

MEMORIAL DAY

CHRISTMAS (OBSERVED)

FOURTH OF JULY (OBSERVED) (OTHER HOLIDAY OR SPECIAL EVENT)
LABOR DAY

THE PERIOD OF TIME THAT THE LANES ARE TO BE OPEN DEPENDS ON THE DAY OF THE WEEK ON WHICH THE HOLIDAY OR SPECIAL EVENT FALLS. THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE SHALL BE USED TO DETERMINE THIS PERIOD:

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IT IS THE INTENT TO MINIMIZE THE IMPACT TO THE TRAVELING PUBLIC.
LANE CLOSURES OR RESTRICTIONS OVER SEGMENT OF THE PROJECT IN
WHICH NO WORK IS ANTICIPATED WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME FRAME,
AS DETERMINED BY THE ENGINEER, SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED. THE
LEVEL OF UTILIZATION OF MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC DEVICES SHALL
BE COMMENSURATE WITH THE WORK IN PROGRESS.

ALL WORK AND TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES SHALL BE IN
ACCORDANCE WITH C&MS 614 AND OTHER APPLICABLE
PORTIONS OF THE SPECIFICATIONS, AS WELL AS THE OHIO
MANUAL OF UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES. PAYMENT
FOR ALL LABOR, EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS SHALL BE
INCLUDED IN THE LUMP SUM CONTRACT PRICE FOR ITEM 614,
MAINTAINING TRAFFIC, UNLESS SEPARATELY ITEMIZED IN THE
PLAN.

NOTIFICATION OF TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT, THE
CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE PROJECT ENGINEER IN
WRITING OF ALL TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS AND UPCOMING
MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC CHANGES. THE CONTRACTOR
SHALL ENSURE THE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION IS SUBMITTED IN
A TIMELY MANNER TO ALLOW THE PROJECT ENGINEER TO MEET
THE REQUIRED TIME FRAMES SET FORTH IN THE TABLE BELOW
TO INFORM THE SPECIAL HAULING PERMITS SECTION
(HAULING.PERMITS@DOT.OHIO.GOV) AND THE DISTRICT PUBLIC
INFORMATION OFFICE (PIO). THIS NOTIFICATION SHALL BE
RECEIVED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER PRIOR TO THE PHYSICAL
SETUP OF ANY APPLICABLE SIGNS OR MESSAGE BOARDS.

NOTIFICATION OF TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS (CONT.)

INFORMATION SHOULD INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ALL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES THAT IMPACT OR INTERFERE WITH TRAFFIC AND SHALL LIST THE SPECIFIC LOCATION, TYPE OF WORK, ROAD STATUS, DATE AND TIME OF RESTRICTION, DURATION OF RESTRICTION, NUMBER OF LANES MAINTAINED, NUMBER OF LANES CLOSED, MINIMUM VERTICAL CLEARANCE, MINIMUM WIDTH OF DRIVABLE PAVEMENT, DETOUR ROUTES, IF APPLICABLE, AND ANY OTHER INFORMATION REQUESTED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER.

WORK ZONE PAVEMENT MARKINGS OR PERMANENT MARKINGS UPON
COMPLETION OF THE ASPHALT SURFACE COURSE PRIOR TO
OPENING THE ROADWAY TO TRAFFIC.

THE FOLLOWING ESTIMATED QUANITIES HAVE BEEN CARRIED TO THE GENERAL SUMMARY FOR USE AT LOCATIONS IDENTIFIED BY THE ENGINEER FOR WORK ZONE PAVEMENT MARKINGS PER THE REQUIREMENTS OF C&MS 614.11.

OTHER THAN THE USES SPECIFIED BELOW SHALL NOT BE
PERMITTED AT PROJECT COST NOR TIME COMPENSATION.
LEOS SHOULD NOT BE USED WHERE THE OMUTCD INTENDS THAT
FLAGGERS BE USED.

IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF C&MS 614 AND
THE OMUTCD, A UNIFORMED LEO WITH AN OFFICIAL PATROL
CAR (CAR WITH TOP-MOUNTED EMERGENCY FLASHING LIGHTS
AND COMPLETE MARKINGS OF THE APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT
AGENCY) SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR THE FOLLOWING TRAFFIC
CONTROL TASKS:

DURING THE ENTIRE ADVANCE PREPARATION AND CLOSURE SEQUENCE WHERE COMPLETE BLOCKAGE OF TRAFFIC IS REQUIRED.

DURING A TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION WHEN IMPACTING THE NORMAL FUNCTION OF THE SIGNAL OR THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC, OR WHEN TRAFFIC NEEDS TO BE DIRECTED THROUGH AN ENERGIZED TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTRARY TO THE SIGNAL DISPLAY (E.G., DIRECTING MOTORISTS THROUGH A RED LIGHT).

DURING PERIODS WHERE TRAFFIC NEEDS TO BE
DIRECTED CONTRARY TO A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE
(FLAGGER, SIGN [E.G. STOP SIGN, STREET OR HIGHWAY
SIGNS, ETC], SIGNAL OR OTHER DEVICE USED TO REGULATE,
WARN OR GUIDE TRAFFIC). TRAFFIC IN THIS INSTANCE
INCLUDES VEHICULAR,

PEDESTRIAN AND/OR SHARED USE PATH USERS.

IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENT OF C&MS 614 AND THE OMUTCD, A UNIFORMED LEO WITH AN OFFICIAL PATROL CAR (CAR WITH TOP-MOUNTED EMERGENCY FLASHING LIGHTS AND COMPLETE MARKINGS OF THE APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY) SHOULD BE PROVIDED FOR THE FOLLOWING TRAFFIC CONTROL TASKS AS APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER:

FOR LANE CLOSURES THAT MEET ALL OF THE CRITERIA LISTED BELOW: DURING INITIAL SET-UP PERIODS, TEAR DOWN PERIODS, SUBSTANTIAL SHIFTS OF A CLOSURE POINT OR WHEN NEW LANE CLOSURE ARRANGEMENTS ARE INITIATED FOR LONG-TERM LANE CLOSURES/SHIFTS (FOR THE FIRST AND LAST DAY OF MAJOR CHANGES IN TRAFFIC CONTROL SETUP).

CRITERIA

ON A MULTI-LANE DIVIDED INTERSTATE, OTHER FREEWAY OR EXPRESSWAY; AND,

AN AUTHORIZED SPEED LIMIT OF 45 MPH OR GREATER THAT IS IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF THE OPERATION; AND, AADT OF 50,000 (OR AADT OF 30,000 WITH 25% OR HIGHER PERCENT TRUCKS)

IN GENERAL, LEOS SHOULD BE POSITIONED IN ADVANCE OF AND ON THE SAME SIDE AS THE LANE RESTRICTION (OR AT THE POINT OF ROAD CLOSURE), AND TO MANUALLY CONTROL TRAFFIC MOVEMENTS THROUGH SIGNALIZED INTERSECTIONS AND/OR IN CONTRARY TO OTHER TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN WORK ZONES.

LEOS SHOULD NOT FORGO THEIR TRAFFIC CONTROL RESPONSIBILITIES TO APPREHEND MOTORISTS FOR ROUTINE TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS. HOWEVER, IF A MOTORISTâ??S ACTIONS ARE CONSIDERED TO BE RECKLESS, THEN PURSUIT OF THE MOTORIST IS APPROPRIATE.

ITEM 614, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER (WITH PATROL CAR) FOR ASSISTANCE DURING CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS, (CONT.)

THE LEOS WORK AT THE DIRECTION OF THE CONTRACTOR.

THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SECURING THE SERVICES

OF THE LEOS WITH THE APPROPRIATE AGENCIES AND COMMUNICATING

THE INTENTIONS OF THE PLANS WITH RESPECT TO DUTIES OF THE LEOS.

THE ENGINEER SHALL HAVE FINAL CONTROL OVER THE LEOSâ?? DUTIES AND PLACEMENT, AND WILL RESOLVE ANY ISSUES THAT MAY ARISE BETWEEN THE TWO PARTIES.

ENSURE PROVIDED LEOS HAVE BEEN TRAINED APPROPRIATE TO THE JOB DECISIONS THEY ARE REQUIRED TO MAKE WHILE ON THE PROJECT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH C&MS 614.03. THE LEO SHALL REPORT IN TO THE CONTRACTOR PRIOR TO THE START OF THE SHIFT, IN ORDER TO RECEIVE INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING SPECIFIC WORK ASSIGNMENTS DURING HIS/HER SHIFT. THE LEO IS EXPECTED TO STAY AT THE PROJECT SITE FOR THE ENTIRE DURATION OF HIS/HER SHIFT. THE LEO SHALL REPORT TO THE CONTRACTOR AT THE END OF HIS/HER SHIFT. SHOULD IT BE NECESSARY TO LEAVE THE PROJECT SITE, THE LEO SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE THE LEOWITH A TWO-WAY COMMUNICATION DEVICE THAT SHALL BE RETURNED TO THE CONTRACTOR AT THE END OF HIS/HER SHIFT.

LEOS (WITH PATROL CAR) REQUIRED BY THE TRAFFIC MAINTENANCE TASKS ABOVE SHALL BE PAID FOR ON A UNIT PRICE (HOURLY) BASIS UNDER ITEM 614, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER (WITH PATROL CAR) FOR ASSISTANCE. THE FOLLOWING ESTIMATED QUANTITIES HAVE BEEN CARRIED TO THE GENERAL SUMMARY.

ITEM 614, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WITH PATROL CAR FOR ASSISTANCE 500 HOURS

THE HOURS PAID SHALL INCLUDE ANY MINIMUM SHOW-UP TIME REQUIRED BY THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY INVOLVED. ANY ADDITIONAL COSTS (ADMINISTRATIVE OR OTHERWISE) INCURRED BY THE CONTRACTOR TO OBTAIN THE SERVICES OF AN LEO ARE INCLUDED WITH THE BID UNIT PRICE FOR ITEM 614, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WITH PATROL CAR FOR ASSISTANCE.
