1st Tract

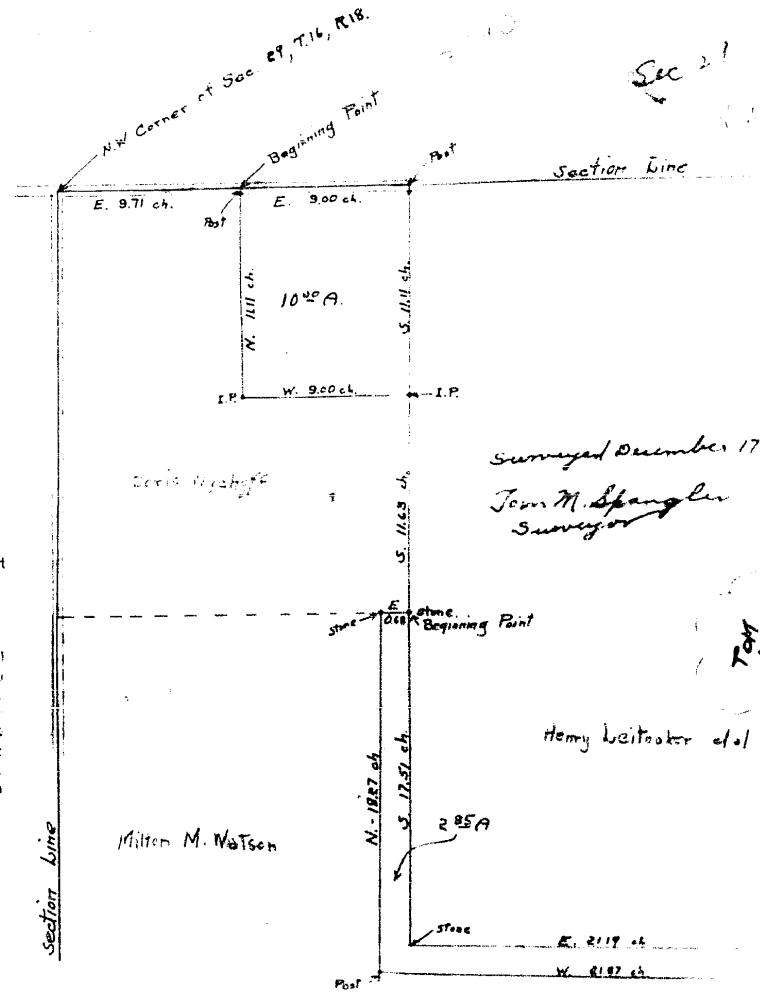
