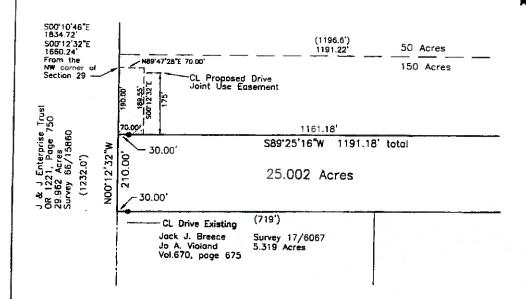

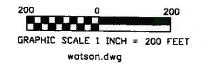




PLAT OF JOINT USE DRIVE EASEMENT

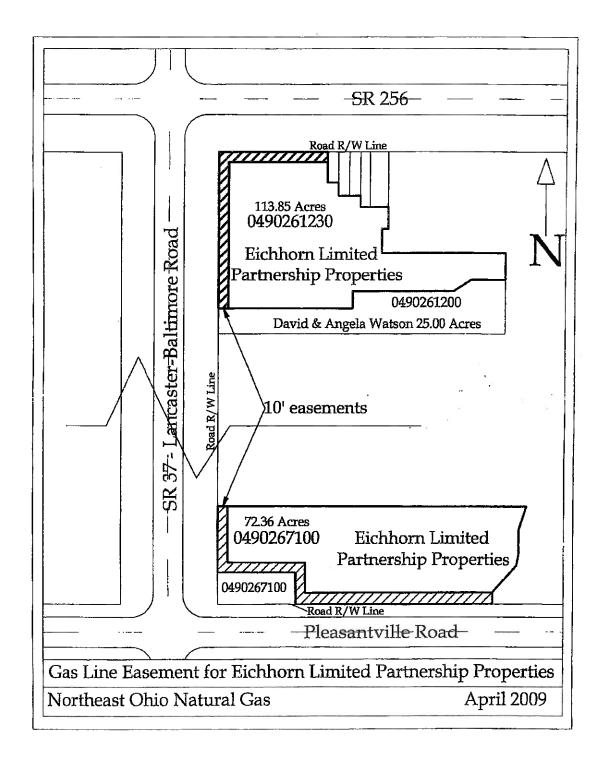

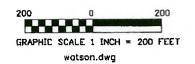
