From 2017 to 2020 (2020 crash data has not been finalized), there have been 4 crashes which appear to have occurred at/on 1175 Baltimore Somerset Road Northeast, Baltimore, OH:

- 1 EB fixed object in wet/rainy roadway conditions
- 1 EB distracted driving (phone-related) fixed object crash
- 1 WB fixed object crash involving wet roadway conditions and a sleeping/fatigued/fainted driver
- 1 fatal WB fixed object crash involving a 18 year old driver. Driver alcohol/drug testing unknown. Both occupant and driver were unbelted.

All were single vehicle crashes. I did not observe a particular trend. Speed may have been a factor in these crashes due to the flat terrain. We could review the area for drainage issues but GE streetview does not show anything visually irregular/concerning.
