The Office of Roadway Engineering reviewed the subject report and determined the proposed improvements will not have a significant adverse impact on the safety or operations in the study area.

The study meets ODOT requirements for an Interchange Operations Study (IOS) and therefore is approved.

Multiple locations on I-670 WB and 4th Street have failing traffic operations (LOS F); however, the No-Build and Build conditions operate similarly. The proposed improvements help to ensure queuing from the I-670 WB off-ramp to 4th Street do not extend to mainline. Improvements to I-670 WB will be required in the future.

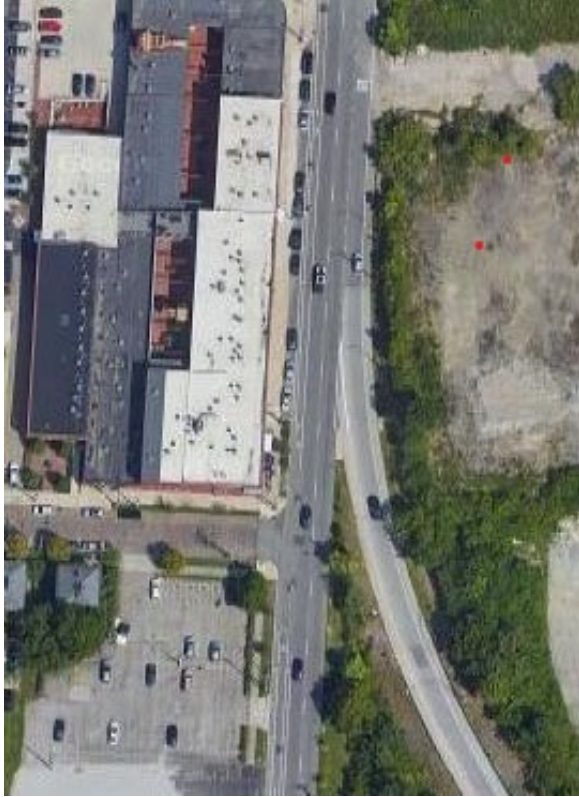
Attached are schematics showing the No-Build condition (existing) and Build condition (proposed improvements).
